

## Announcement of The National Health Commission Office (NHCO) Thailand on Not Accepting Gifts and Gratuities from Performing Duties (No Gift Policy) For Fiscal Year 2026 (B.E.2569)

I, Dr. Suthep Petchmark, Secretary-General of the National Health Commission, along with the Executive Board and staff of the National Health Commission Office (NHCO), which has a role in promoting a participatory public policy process based on wisdom for the well-being of society, hereby declare:

- 1. To raise awareness on performing duties with an emphasis on the prevention of all forms of corruption, maintaining transparency, integrity, and morality, and avoiding conflicts of interest in accordance with the 2nd Suchon Charter, particularly the chapter on Good Governance Organization. This chapter states that "NHCO staff will not seek benefits, whether direct or indirect, from their performance and will comply with NHCO policies and regulations, especially the No Gift Policy."
- 2. To declare an intention to execute duties with transparency, honesty, and accountability in accordance with NHCO regulations on promoting morality and good governance.
- NHCO staff will not accept gifts or gratuities related to their duties, including before, during, or after their performance, to prevent corruption now and in the future.

This declaration is hereby announced and shall be adhered to by all.
